The ArcGIS Storymap Competition is open to ALL High School (grade 9-12) and Middle School (grade 5-8) students resident in Delaware.

To participate, students must create a map-based story that explores the issue of **SUSTAINABILITY and examines a sustainability challenge at either the school, community, state or national level.**

Prizes will be awarded to top scoring submissions at both the Middle School and High School levels.

GeoMentors are available to help students (and teachers) translate their ideas into storymaps.
