



Listed are some recommendations for next year's tennis tournament that the committee decided on.

- 1. On the sheet that the coach sends to Roy Rylander listing his or her team, they give the win-loss record for each entry but list all the teams and scores for any player to be considered for seeding. By so doing this will make less of a task for the coach and will make it easier for the committee when checking the entries.
- 2. If during the season the coach makes any changes in his told doubles teams he or she should only enter the scores of those players that are being entered in the tournament.
- 3. Private schools may submit out-of-state scores to be considered by the tournament committee.
- 4. Placing players may be considered at the discretion of the tournament committee.
- 5. Coaches should have the courtesy of calling the director if for some reason one of his or her players cannot make it.
- 6. If for some reason matches are delayed in starting, the down state teams should be scheduled first.
- 7. 1st and 2nd doubles matches will be played at different locations next year thereby cutting down on the length of time.
- 8. Two matches will be played on Saturday exclusive of byes.
- 9. Beginning with quarter finals all girl matches will be played at one site.
- 10. All players, regardless of byes, must report at 9 a.m.
- 11. The committee recommended Feb. 7th as a good date for the tennis clinic.
- Note-George Plitnik, Athletic Director at Newark High School, has graciously accepted the chairmanship of the D.S.S.A.A Tennis Committee for the school year 1975-76

STATE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIP FINAL REPORT 1978

The Delaware Secondary School Athletic Association State High School Tennis Tournament began Saturday, May 20, 1978 and ended with the championship round on Thursday, May 25. Twenty-nine different schools were represented. Fifty-two teams were entered - 28 boys teams and 24 girls teams for a total of 191 male entries and 168 female entries. This is a record number of male and female entries.

Six different sites were used on opening day. These were as follows: Glasgow High School - Girls Singles; Christiana High School - Girls 2nd Doubles; Delaware Field House Courts - Girls 1st Doubles; University Academy Street Courts - Boys Singles; Carpenter Sports Building Courts - Boys 1st Doubles; New High School - Boys 2nd Doubles.

On Monday, May 22, 1978 Boys Singles were held at the Academy Street courts, Boys Doubles at Carpenter Sports Building, Girls Singles at Glasgow High School, Girls Doubles at Delaware Field House. On Tuesday, May 23, 1978 all boys matches were held at the Academy Street courts and all girls matches at Glasgow High School. Rain on Wednesday caused the finals to be played on Thursday May 25, 1978. All finals were played at Delaware Field House.

In the boys division, Concord finished in 1st place with 23 points and Brandywine in 2nd place with 22 points. In the girls division, Brandywine placed 1st with 23 points and Concrod 2nd with 14 points.

DSSAA State Tennis Championships - 1979 Final Report

The DSSAA State High School Tennis Tournament began on Monday, May 21, 1979 and ended on Friday, May 25. Forty-nine teams were entered - 24 boys teams and 25 girls teams for a total of 162 boys entries and 161 girls entries.

No matches were played on Saturday, the usual opening day, or on Wednesday or Thursday because of rain. On Friday, most semifinal and all final rounds were completed at the Delaware Field House.

In the girls division, Brandywine finished in 1st place with 25 points and Concord in 2nd place with 19 points.

In the boys division, Concord finished in 1st place (for the second straight year) with 27 points. Brandywine and Dover finished in a tie for 2nd place with 18 points each.
