FINAL REPORT

The tennis tournament began on Saturday, May l6th, with the completion of two rounds. There were 160 boys from 24 schools entered and 127 girls from 19 schools entered. ## FINAL REPORT

The tennis tournament began on Saturday, May 15 with the completion of two rounds. There was a record turn-out with 188 boys from 27 schools and 157 girls from 25 schools. Quarter finals, semi-finals and finals were played on the l7th, 18 th and 19 th respectively.

In the girl's division Tower Hill won four of the five events for a total of 26 points, more than twice the number of points of the nearest competitor.
