Girls' 3rd Singles



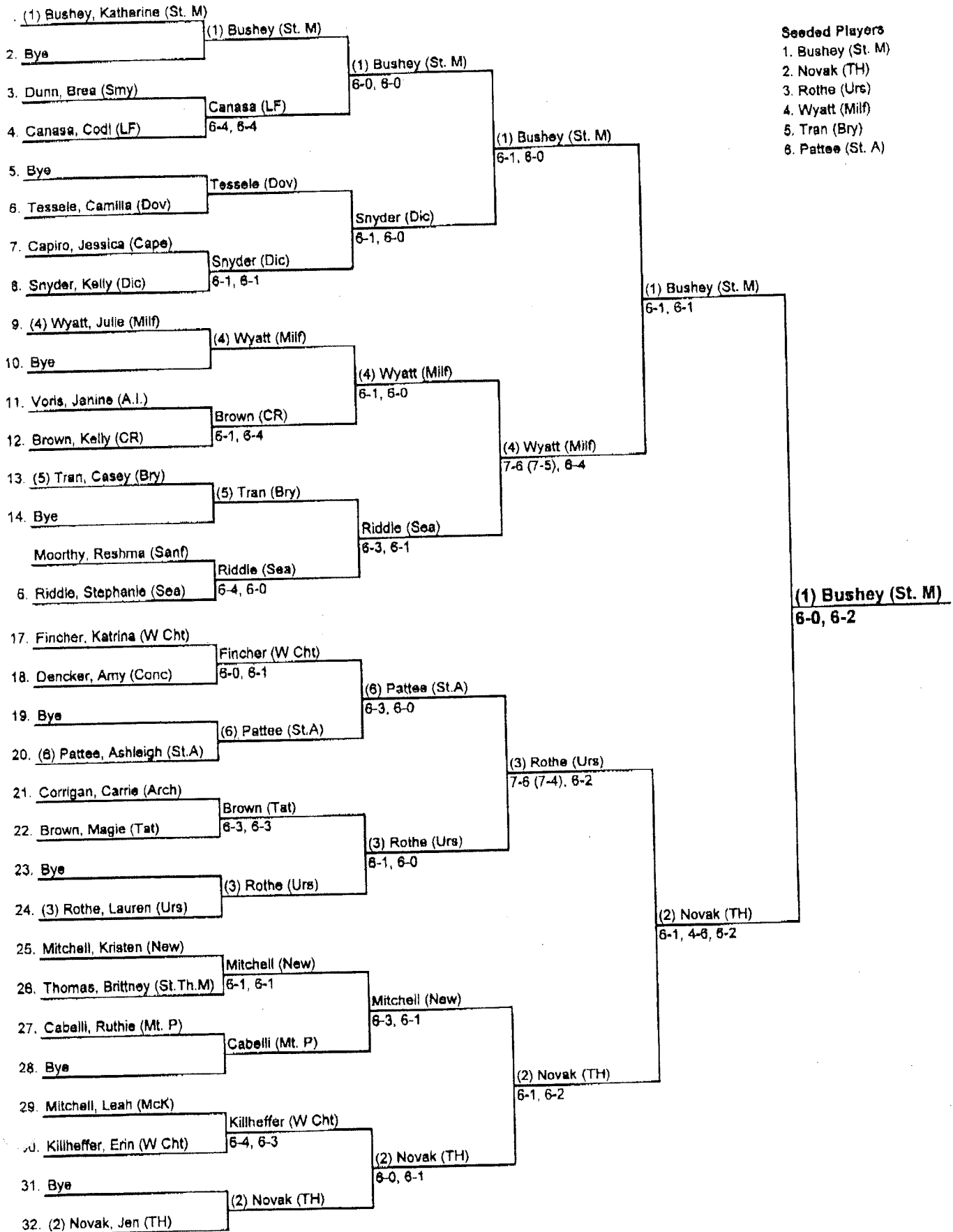

Boys' 3rd Singles



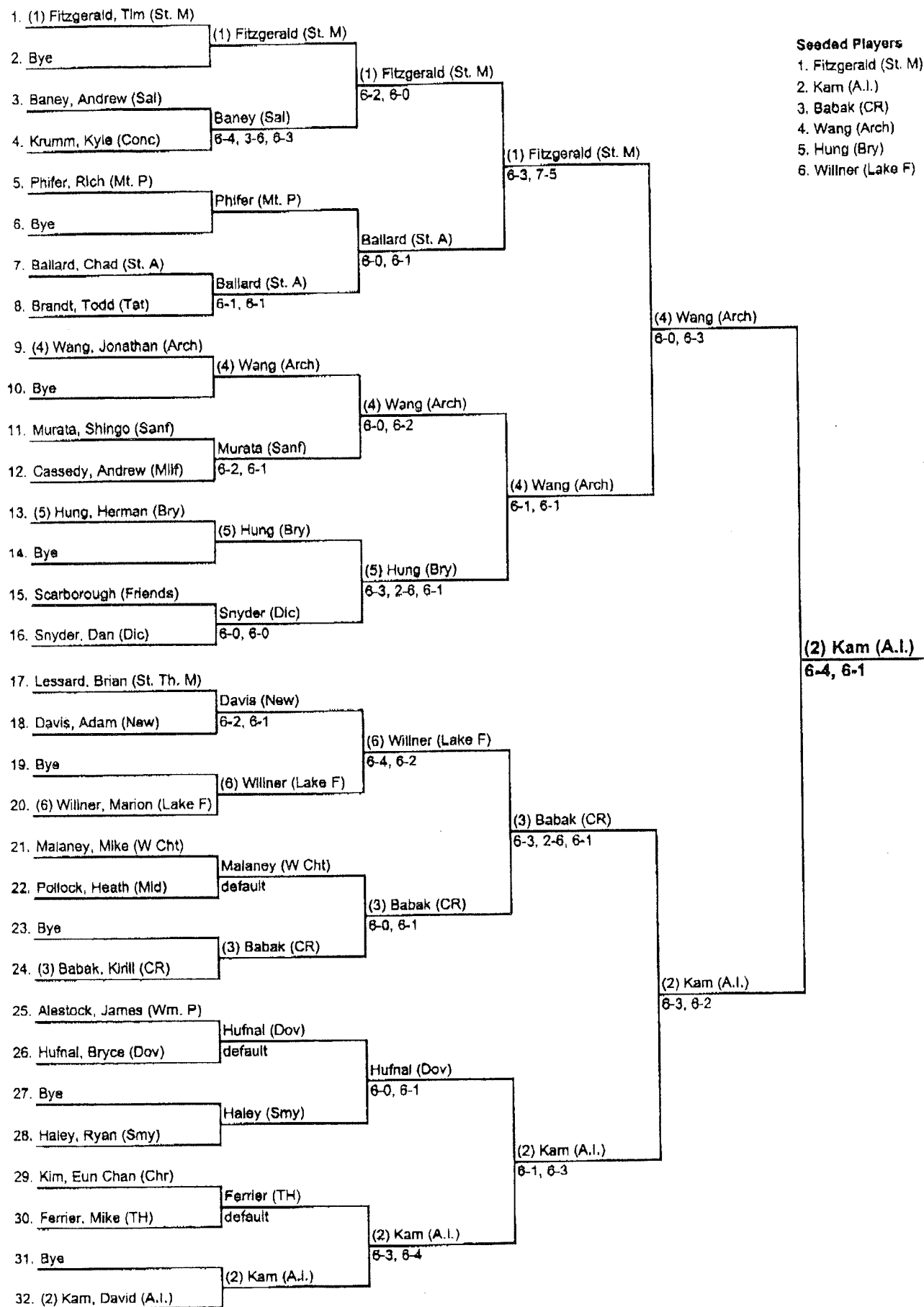

This was the second year in the 2 year cycle of a seperate boys and girls, open state tournament. The boys tournament began on 5/18 and the girls on 5/25. The only rain delay in the entire 2 weeks was on the first saturday. The boys first round matches were delayed until 1:00. Most of the courts were dry enough to begin playing at that time. The first doubles site @ Poly tech were soaked and required the most work. Due to their late start, the 2nd round of the 1st doubles draw was played on Monday,5/20, @ 1:00 (Glasgow H.S.) The quarter finals were played @ 4:00 on 5/20 @ Glasgow H.S.,CSB, and DFH. The semi finals on Tuesday, 5/21 @CSB and DFH, and the finals on Wednesday, 5/23 @ DFH. There were 24 entries in the first singles and first doubles positions. Seconds singles had 22 entries, third singles had 23 entries and the second doubles draw had 21 entries. 26 of the 30 possible schools were represented. Due to the delayed start, a larger number of defaults are to be expected. There were 15 defaults, which came from 5 schools.
