

Emergency Action Plan Alumni Stadium

Alumni Stadium Emergency Personnel: Certified Athletic Trainer on site for competition and practices; additional Sports Medicine Staff accessible from Athletic Training Room. Coaches are on site for all practices and are certified in First Aid and CPR/AED.

Emergency Communication: Working cellular phone, and Walkie Talkies are in the Athletic Training room, home sideline, and on Emergency Personnel. Additional campus emergency phones are located just outside of the main entrance of the Stadium.


Emergency Equipment: A Red Emergency Bag is located on the Home sideline. The Emergency Bag contains the following: AED, Emergency Oxygen, Airways, Splints, Cervical immobilizer, Emergency Blanket, and Epi-pen. Also available are vacuum splint bags and spine boards. Additional AED located in the next to the Equipment room under the Stadium.

Roles of First Responders

1. Immediate care of the injured or ill student-athlete
2. Emergency equipment retrieval
3. **Activation of emergency medical system (EMS)** a. Call 911 (provide name, address, telephone number; number of individuals injured; condition of injured; first aid treatment provided; specific directions; other information as requested)
4. **Direction of EMS to scene** a. Enter Alumni Stadium: Enter using the main entrance to campus. After the security booth, turn right head towards Alumni Stadium, go two-thirds of the way towards the circle to the West End of the Stadium. Make a right turn into the West entrance just behind the west endzone. EMS staff can enter the stadium through the two gates and enter onto the track.. A designate individual to "flag down" EMS and direct to scene will be posted in front of the west entrance to the stadium and direct the Ambulance to the designated area. 2. Designated Scene controller: limit scene to first aid providers and move bystanders away from area. For all home competition a BLS unit will be parked next to the west entrance located just inside of the track.

NOTE: Please notify the staff Athletic Trainer responsible for the team as soon as possible if he/she is not present at the scene.
