

On Behalf of the State Wrestling Committee,

Welcome to the 33rd^d annual Dual Team Championship tournament Wednesday, February 11 & Saturday, February 14, 2026.

Round ONE Wednesday will be hosted by the Four Highest seeded teams in both Divisions I and II at 7 PM.

Semifinals at 2:00 PM and 4:00 PM followed by the Championship Round @ 6:00 PM at Smyrna on Saturday, 2/14/2026.

I have attached three documents that will help organize your experience at this tournament and make it more enjoyable. **This information will be for the eight advancing teams from Round One.**

The first is a document called **Smyrna High School Wrestling Event Map** which will show where to drop off your wrestlers, where to send the wrestlers to weigh in for the tournament, and where to park the busses. On Saturday weigh-ins will begin at 1:00 PM, please plan to arrive **(no earlier than 12:30 PM)**. All parking lots will be available for Spectator parking.

The second document is for Saturday and is called **Dual Team Championship-GYM configuration**. Signs will be posted to show where your wrestlers should sit with their gym bags and other equipment for the first round. The teams that lose **must** relocate so that the advancing teams can move to the ends of the gym in order to keep the mat area clear.

The third document is **Dual Team Tournament Seeding** which is the list of tournament teams along with the bracketing for the tournament.

Coaches or statisticians must submit their list of up to 28 wrestlers on the 2026 DIAA Team Championships Trackwrestling event. The roster deadline is Tuesday 2/11/26 by 10:00 PM. On Saturday, coaches will receive duplicates of all weigh-in verification sheets of the teams in your division before the matches begin. Wednesday's weigh-ins will establish entry and classify the wrestlers for both days of the tournament. Wrestlers must weigh-in both days to be eligible. **Weigh-ins will be in the order of matches based on the draw.**

Each Team will be allotted the following complimentary admissions:

6 Team Personnel Typically-1 Head Coach, 2 Assistant coaches, 2 managers, 1 Trainer

Up to 28 contestants that are listed on the weigh-in roster and officially weigh-in

All other persons will need to purchase admission and enter through the spectator entrance. The allotted coaches and managers will have their hands stamped by the assigned committee member. Coaches may enter the gym or remain in the weigh-in area or locker room with their wrestlers. Managers will be admitted into the gym. Wrestlers will remain in the weigh-in area or designated locker room areas for lavatory purposes until weigh-ins are concluded.

Upon certification at weigh-in, the contestants will have their hands stamped at the scale and then be admitted into the gym or lockers areas.

Please feel free to duplicate any of these sheets at your discretion for distribution to your fans so they know where to enter the gym and where to sit so they may be closest to your team.

We look forward to having you at this tournament.
