















# Get Ready For Kindergarten



You will need the following items to register your child for kindergarten in Delaware:

 <p><b>Local School District/ Charter School Registration Information</b></p>	<p>Contact the school district/charter school where your child will be attending to request school registration information and calendars of important dates.</p>	
 <p><b>Original Birth Certificate</b></p>	<p>If you do not have the original birth certificate, contact the Office of Vital Statistics for a copy: Dover: 302-744-4549 • Newark: 302-283-7130 • Georgetown: 302-856-5495 There is a \$25 Replacement Fee. <b>Contact the Office of Vital Statistics to ask about financial assistance</b> • 877-888-0248</p>	
 <p><b>Proof of Immunizations</b></p>	<p>At your child's 5-year-old well visit, ask your doctor to complete a "Delaware General Physical Form" for kindergarten registration.</p>	
 <p><b>Proof of a Physical Exam</b></p>	<p><b>OR</b></p> <p>Call your child's doctor to schedule a physical exam. Take the physical exam form included in your school registration information and ask for a completed form to provide to the school.</p>	
 <p><b>Lead test/ Tuberculosis test</b></p>	<p>Be sure to schedule immunizations, a lead test, and a Tuberculosis tests during your child's physical exam.</p> <p><b>For more information, contact the Division of Public Health</b> • 302-744-1060</p>	
 <p><b>Proof of Residence</b></p>	<p>Ask your school for its specific list of what will serve as proof of residency and gather those documents.</p>	

Be sure to ask your school about any additional documents required for registration.
