Process for Providing Public Comment at Board Meetings

The State Board of Education values input and feedback from Delaware citizens on the matters that come before it.

Public Comment at Regular Board Meetings:

Members of the public are welcome to speak before the State Board of Education during the scheduled public comment period at every regular board meeting. Public comment sign-up sheets are located at the entrance of the Board meeting room on the day of the meeting. While meetings are held virtually, persons wishing to address the Board can send their name, the name of their group (if speaking on behalf of a group), and the topic of their comment to Delaware.SBE@sbe.k12.de.us by 4pm on the day of the meeting.

Opportunity to sign up will also be provided during the meeting. At the designated time, the Board President will read the names on the sign-up sheet in the order in which individuals have signed up.

To provide all members of the public with an equal opportunity to speak to the board, each organization is limited to three minutes and individuals are limited to two minutes, unless otherwise noted.

Please Note: Normally, the Board will not respond to questions by or engage in a dialogue with those offering comments in writing or during the Board meeting, but may respond in writing to a person or group.
