Cadet Performance Goals for the New Charter Term

Goal 1: Each year, ELA, Math, Social Studies, and Science test scores will increase the percent proficient.

Goal 2: Math has consistently been the area that falls farthest below state averages. By the end of the Charter term, Math performance will increase to match or exceed the state average.

In order to achieve these goals, FSMA has plans to:

- Implement a consistent Math curriculum across grade levels that uses Illustrative Math as it's base.
- Provided dedicated content aread PLC time to analyze assessment data and determin greatest areas of need to inform instruction
- Provide professional learning to support special education needs, particularly differentiation, sinec FSMA has a large cadet population with IEPs and 504s.

- Leverage our Enrichment period to focus on testing strategies and preparedness, as well as basic study skills to improve cadet motivation and participation in standardized testing and assessments.
- Begin monthly Parent University meetings to show parents how to access resources to support cadets via academics as well as preparing for life after high school.
