As this curriculum is standards-aligned, the adoption allowed for school leaders to maximize opportunities for interdisciplinary connections and vertical alignment. The layout and format of the EL Education curriculum aligned well with different areas of growth for the KACS educators, including the providing of structures and protocols that elevate student voice and collaboration, and differentiating lessons in order to meet the needs of all learners.

Kuumba Academy Charter School, in partnership with EL Education, strives to promote instruction that is alive with discovery, inquiry, critical thinking, problem solving and collaboration. Teachers talk less. Students talk and think more. Lessons challenge, engage, and empower students with complex issues, text, and problems.
