Chronology

It is one of the most important things historians do!

Historians use <u>chronology</u> to make sense of what happened in the past. They organize events that happened in the past into the order in which they occurred - first, next, then, last. This helps them draw conclusions about what might have caused an event to happen and what might be some effects of that event happening.

Chronology:


the arrangement of events or dates in the order that they occurred.


