The social worker will collaborate with the members of the school-based mental health team to provide wrap-around services for students, families, and staff. The expected impact is to improve school connectedness, increase attendance rates, decrease retention rates and improve the overall quality of the student's well-being. We are seeking qualified Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSW), as per State regulations to engage with our students. LCSWs will work with a diverse group of students, including those who are low-income, homeless or in foster care, and/or multi-language learners. They will provide support to students so that they may achieve their academic, social, and emotional goals
