She supports all of our students while she also has a caseload she supports on a more frequent basis. 81.65% of the students at EastSide are low-income families and though our social worker does not solely focus on this group of students her annual caseload is mostly if not completely made up of low-income students. Her caseload changes each year based on the needs of our students as she looks to support those who need her most. In her role, our Social Worker helps implement the School's MTSS plan as well as working in conjunction with the entire Mental Health team to ensure fidelity.
