* Appropriation 05311 will also support the Salary and OECs for our Wilson Reading and MLL student teacher, Doreen Rathmell.	* \$ 32,152.00	* Ms. Rathmell services over 30% of the students at GCS, almost all of whom fall under the MLL and LI umbrella. Students receive instruction in phonemic awareness, alphabetic principle, decoding, encoding, advanced word analysis, high frequency/sight word instruction, vocabulary development, single word automaticity and fluency with connected text, oral expressive language development, listening and reading comprehension with visualization, and metacognition. Students are pulled into small groups of 1 to 5 instruction. Ms. Rathmell tracks individual growth through quarterly assessments. The expected impact on students that are served in our Wilson Reading and MLL programs is 1-2 years of growth in reading.
