

The social worker is key in a school with disadvantaged students as they provide a focused reach with specific students in the area of social emotional and mental health needs. They are uniquely trained to integrate the school community and family context into interventions and resource referrals. The social worker will work with many outside community programs to connect students and families to services and needed items such as bedding, food, shelter, clothing, and more. Effectiveness will be measured by reviewing outside agency placements and risk assessment data. We would expect that having a full-time social worker will reduce the number of outside agency placements and the number of high or moderate risk assessments. We also measure effectiveness by reviewing discipline data.
