* Supervisor of Instruction (World Language, MLL, Immersion, Social Studies, Data, Etc...) .7 FTE	* \$ 107,000.00	* This position will oversee the submission, management, and evaluation of this grant. This position oversees everything that takes place in the district with our multilingual learners (MLL), their families, and our schools. In some cases, the low income students are also MLL. The position also works closely with all schools, but specifically oversees our middle school administrators for their evaluations and focuses on MLL and low income students there as well. The position also is designated as our "data" person so using data to drive instruction for our various subgroups is here too. We chose to do part of the salary based on how much time was devoted to working with these identified students.
* Data Service Center MLL Access	* \$ 6,600.00	* Provides access to teachers for "Can Do" steps and recent ACCESS student reports. Teachers' plans can be individualized based on student needs. Effectiveness will be measured by classroom grades and ACCESS score growth. (supports all 15 schools)
* .3 Supervisor of Instruction	* \$ 50,000.00	* .3 of Kim Corbiel's salary. Her supervisor duties include working with DO Connector assigned schools. She works regularly with schools focused on data for identified groups of students including MLL and low income. She also ensures the MLL population have equitable access to CTE at all levels. She also oversees math and science and is working to close the gap for these two subgroups districtwide.

* .3 Supervisor of Instruction	* \$ 52,000.00	* .3 of Barb Miklus salary. Her supervisor duties include working with DO Connector assigned schools. She works regularly with schools focused on data for identified groups of students including MLL and low income. In addition, she oversees ELA and summer programming which are large components to ensure equitable practices are in place especially for low income and MLL students. Districtwide professional learning includes best practices for MLL and special education students.
* Before/After Summer School Programming k - 12	* \$ 101,487.73	* This year our summer school numbers for MLL students doubled from 40 participants to over 80 at the elementary level. This is not a mandatory summer school, but more an opportunity for field trips, language immersion opportunities and includes movement, the arts, etc...
* Curriculum and Instruction Resources and Professional Development	* \$ 100,000.00	* Additional curriculum resources that are high quality that have components that specifically support MLL and low income students. (Ex: ARC provides books that look like chapter books, but are on a lower reading level so students appear to reading the same text as their peers, but it is on the level in which they can access English.) This year, CR has made a shift to service our MLL students in their homeschools so they do not need to shuttle to one school. To support this shift professional learning has been planned to provide staff with tools to meet the needs of the new populations in their schools.
