* Employ 1 Part-time Student Support Services Specialist	* \$ 42,000.00	* DMA will continue to employ a part-time Student Support Specialist focus and support our low-income students. We anticipate a current staff member will continue to fill this position. The Student Support Specialist will provide support and mentorship to our DMA cadets, with a special focus on those cadets that are classified as low income. Our goal is to foster a positive environment that increases the learning potential for our cadets through relationship building based on trust and understanding. The Student Support Specialist will meet with low-income cadets on a regular basis to develop individualized education and study plans and to coach each cadet towards academic success. The Student Support Specialist will work with educators and administration to provide guidance in the selection of quality instructional materials and ways to best implement best practices to improve academic outcomes for identified low-income cadets.
* Provide group tutoring for MLL cadets through Back to Basics	* \$ 10,000.00	* DMA will contract with Back to Basics to provide small group MLL instruction for our growing MLL population.
* Creation of a school based uniform/school supply closet	* \$ 9,437.92	* DMA will create a school-based program to provide uniform items that are not provided by the US Navy. This would include items like white t-shirts, black dress socks, extra uniform covers, as well as required school supplies. These items would be available to our SEP population as needed.
