* Hiring of EL K8 Teacher	* \$ 62,601.00	* MOT Charter School is hiring a certified EL teacher in our K8 building for the first time. This is a new position for us and will directly impact the success of our EL students. Opportunity funds will pay approximately 50 percent of the staff member (Chris Low's) salary. Specifically, the EL students will graduate out of the EL program at a higher rate and will showed increased achievement in the subjects covered by EL instruction (reading, writing, speaking and listening) as measured by ACCESS scores and NWEA scores..
* Continued funding of HS SEL Counselor	* \$ 59,301.00	* MOT Charter High School will continue to use Opportunity Funds to pay 60 percent of the salary of a SEL counselor (Kandis LeBron) to support the needs of SEP students. This counselor is not a college counselor and instead directly addresses the increased needs of SEP students, including issues of homelessness, chronic absenteeism, and high school failure rates. This position will be specifically targeting the chronic absenteeism and failure rates of our SEP students
* Hiring of HS Dean of Students	* \$ 51,901.52	* MOT Charter High School will hire a Dean of Students (Travis Piser) to target the chronic absenteeism associated with SEP Students. Opportunity Funds will be used to pay approximately 50 percent of the salary of the new person in this position. This position will target a decrease in the percentage of SEP students who are identified as chronically absent for being absent more than 10% of school days.
