* Student Support Specialist (10-Month Teacher)	* \$ 147,327.82	* POLYTECH School District will support a Student Support Specialist (teacher position). This position will provide visiting teacher services to our low-income students. Visiting teacher services for low-income students may include, but are not limited to: coordinating supports for homeless and foster care students, coordinating English Language Learner (ELL) services, coordinating homebound education services, and providing consultative services to promote student success in CTE and World Language classrooms. The Student Support Specialist will provide a variety of low-income student supports including, but not limited to: connecting students and families to mental health and wellness supports, conducting academic progress and attendance checks and counseling, arranging transportation services if necessary, and assisting with transitions to post-secondary life (FAFSA and college application completion, employment searches, etc.) This staff member will also connect families to state and community supports and resources as needed.
* ELL Instructor (Partially Funded)	* \$ 67,951.54	* POLYTECH School District will support a portion of a teacher to provide English Language Learner (ELL) instruction and supports to students. (In the past, POLYTECH has contracted these services with an outside vendor). The ELL teacher will provide a variety of supports including, but not limited to: providing ELL instructional services during daily enrichment periods and coaching/consultative services for teachers who serve ELLs or for anyone looking to expand their knowledge of best practices related to providing instruction to ELLs.
