

AIR BRAKE RESTRICTION REMOVAL REQUIREMENT CHECKLIST

If an individual has an Air Brake Restriction (L Restriction) on their license and would like it removed, they must complete the following:

1. Go to the DMV and pass the written test on the Air Brake section of the knowledge test (Section 5) of the CDL Manual if you have not already passed this section.
2. Receive a CDL Permit from DMV after successfully passing their knowledge test; the permit must have the endorsement showing as P & S to be eligible to train and test. If not printed with the P & S, must speak to a Supervisor at the DMV to have resolved before leaving.
3. Work with a Certified Delaware School Bus Driver Trainer and complete the Air Brake Restriction Removal Training & Paperwork, showing proficiency (8 out of 10 times) in the following areas:
 - Vehicle Pre-Trip
 - Air Brake Pre-Trip
 - On Road in Air Brake Bus

Once the driver has completed the Air Brake Restriction Removal training, the primary district that holds the file needs to scan the training paperwork into the driver's file in the Transportation Record System (TRS).

NOTE: All CDL Air Brake Restriction Permits must show a "P" and "S" in the endorsement section, or training and road testing can't occur.

4. The district that is the primary holder of the driver's file needs to ensure that all required credentialing documents have been uploaded into the driver's file in the TRS.
5. Once the driver is ready to complete the road test, the district will request the road test via Schoology.
6. On the day of the scheduled road test, the driver needs to ensure that they come in an air brake bus to complete the road test.
7. If the individual passes the road test, the air brake restriction will be removed from the individual's license.
